


A Word from The Director



MoU Signing Ceremony Between Asia China Education and Culture Association (ACEC) and Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM)

On 24th February 2022, a hybrid signing ceremony was held between Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM), Guilin University of Electronic Technology (GUET) and Asia China Education and Culture (ACEC) Association for the China-ASEAN Alliance of Universities for Electronic Information Innovation of China ASEAN Information Harbor Collaboration Initiative. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and the Collaboration Initiative were officially signed by Professor Datuk Ts. Dr. Wahid bin Razzaly, Vice Chancellor of UTHM, Professor Xu Huarui, President of GUET and Mr Yang Chengcheng, Executive Regional Director of ACEC.

Executive Director of ACEC,Mr Yang Chengcheng expressed that through the platform of China ASEAN Information Harbour Industry-Academia-Research Collaboration Center, it will act as a physical platform for overseas industry-academia-research collaboration. Mr. Yang also hopes that UTHM lecturers and students will go to GUET and other alliance members to teach and exchange, to promote cooperation between the two sides to cultivate more high-quality international talents under the Belt and Road Initiative and promote common progress and development in the region.

GUET President Xu Huarui said that this initiative to build the Alliance Industry-Academia-Research Intercultural Exchange Center aims to provide a cross-cultural exchange service and collaboration platform for the Alliance universities through the cross-cultural industry-academia-research exchange, joint training of talents, sharing of scientific research information, and joint incubation of achievements in the RCEP region. The successful signing of the Initiative and MoU heralded the success of the ceremony and signaled a bright future for cross-cultural industry-academia-research exchange and collaboration in the region.

BRI Cross Cultural Online Exchange Program

BRI Cross-Cultural Online Exchange Programme, organized by Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) and Asia China Education and Culture Association (ACEC). The programme was held on March 5, 2022 – April 30, 2022.

The purpose of the course is to engage in active cultural exchange between China and ASEAN higher learning institutions. In addition, it broadens the worldview of students and understands different countries' history and culture.

This event is designed to allow all participants to actively participate in the program from home despite the current global pandemic. This programme is targeting both local and international students in UTHM, UTHM partner universities and students from Malaysian public universities.

On the 9th March 2022, an Opening Ceremony of the BRI Cross-Cultural Exchange Online Programme was organized by the collaborations between the Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM), Anhui Medical University and the ACEC Association through Zoom Meeting Call as the main platform, including on the ACEC's Facebook Live. To begin with, a welcoming speech by Mr. Yang Cheng Cheng, Executive Director of ACEC, and an opening speech by the honorable Vice-Chancellor of UTHM, Professor Datuk Ts. Dr. Wahid bin Razzaly as part of officiating this virtual ceremony. This opening program aims to significantly build an active engagement in cultural exchange between China and ASEAN higher learning institutions, especially among university students through exposure to informative historical facts about fascinating heritage sites in China's Anhui and Malaysia's Penang and Malacca, which were presented respectively by Mr. Liu from AnHui University and Dr. Indera Syahrul Mat Radzuan from the Faculty of Technology Management and Business of UTHM. On March 10 to 17, 2022, a delegation from UTHM visited 6 educational institutions and Indonesia Government Office around Ponorogo, Nganjuk, Kediri, Tulungagung and Malang, Indonesia.

This visit was led by Dr Siti Marpuah (Lecturer). The universities and industries visited include Pondok Pesantren Wali Songo Putra, with Institut Agama Islam Riyadlotul Mujahidin (IAIRM Ngabar), Universitas Darussalam Gontor (UNIDA), Institut Agama Islam Pangeran, Institut Agama Islam Tribakti Kediri, Universitas Islam Negeri Syarif Hidayatullah Jakarta (UIN) and STAI Mahad Aly Al-Hikam Malang. 
The three schemes and programs presented:




INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TRAVEL DIARIES

3rd June 2022, Russian Embassy in Kuala Lumpur:

The Vice Chancellor held a meeting with the Russian Ambassador to Malaysia, HE Naiyl M. The visit was also attended by the Director of the International Office, Prof. Dr. Chan Chee Ming.







A PROSPECTIVE NETWORKING MEETING WITH RUT (RUSSIAN UNIVERSITY OF TRANSPORT)

A networking meeting was organized between UTHM and the Russian University of Transport (RUT) on the 29th of June 2022, Wednesday. A total of 6 officers from the Faculty of Engineering Technology (FTK) of UTHM participated in this virtual meeting at the Russian House (Russian Centre for Science and Culture), Kuala Lumpur, under the ministration of Madam Svetlana Kovaleva (Director of Russian House) along with her team.

UTHM was led by Prof. Dr. Chan Chee Ming (Director, International Office of UTHM), and assisted by Dr. Mimi Faisyalini Ramli (Head of Department, Transportation Engineering Technology) and Ts. Dr. Sasitharan Nagapan (Head of Department, Global Programmes and Networking, International Office of UTHM). The purpose of this initial networking meeting is to propose and discuss potential collaboration plans through various mutual academic interests such as mobility programs, bilateral supervisor consultations, and research grants significantly in the railway transportation engineering technology field from both universities.

Finally, this session concluded with both parties expected to sign the memorandum of understanding (MoU) in the near future. On behalf of the UTHM, we would like to express our gratitude, especially to all Embassy of Russia and the Russian House attachés involved for moderating this networking meeting successfully. Apart from that, UTHM also anticipates having further bilateral collaboration initiatives with RUT, in the prospect of the education and transportation industry.





TEACHING FACTORY BENCMARK VISIT AND PROMOTING UTHM TO UNIVERSITY AND INDUSTRY IN INDONESIA

4th July until 7th July 2022, Indonesia:

On July 4-7, 2022, a delegation from UTHM visited six educational institutions and the furniture industry around Jepara and Surabaya, Indonesia. A total of 5 officers from UTHM participated in this visit led by Professor Dr. Abdul Talib bin Bon (Director). The visit also promoted UTHM's academic programmes, particularly the new bachelor's degree programme in furniture design and manufacturing, which will be offered to start in 2023.

The universities and industries visited include Petra Christian University in Surabaya, Wijaya Kusuma University in Surabaya (UWKS), Nahdlatul Ulama Jepara Islamic University (UNISNU), Sepuluh Nopember Institute of Technology (ITS), Narotama University (UNNAR), Surabaya State Shipping Polytechnic (PPNS) and the furniture industry in Jepara.

Finally, this visit was to develop benchmarks for the implementation of programmes and training in the UTHM teaching factory and to learn about the latest developments in research and development and furniture design technology in Indonesian universities and industry and both parties agreed to collaborate through MoUs to create a Design Factory Satellite in Teaching Factory, UTHM.







INTERNATIONAL PROMOTION ACTIVITIES: HI-TVET VISIT TO GERMANY

11th July until 18th July 2022, Germany:

Prof. Ts. Dr. Ruzairi Abdul Rahim, the Vice Chancellor of UTHM, visited Germany from July 11 to 18, 2022 and was accompanied by Prof. Madya Ir. Ts. Dr. Bukhari Manshoor (Dean of the Faculty of Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering) and Prof. Madya Ir. Dr. Low Cheng Yee. (Head of the IEM Industry Centre Fraunhofer Innovationlabs.my).



The purpose of the visit was to discuss the forms of cooperation that are in line with UTHM's mission to provide technical solutions to the needs of industry and society, including in academia, student and staff exchanges, research and vocational education consulting.



During the visit, the following universities and companies were visited, among others.

Beckhoff Automation in Verl, GEA Westfalia Separator in Oelde and Diebold Nixdorf in Paderborn, Nordhausen University of Applied Sciences and Heilbronn University of Applied Sciences. Finally, UTHM signed the Letter of Intent (LoI) with Fraunhofer IEM. The ceremony took place at Fraunhofer IEM in Paderborn on July 13, 2022.



INTERNATIONAL PROMOTION ACTIVITIES: PROMOTION OF EDUCATION TO BATAM AND TANJUNG PINANG

21st July until 29th July 2022, Indonesia:

From July 21–29, 2022, a delegation from UTHM visited 12 educational institutions and Indonesian government offices in Batam and Tanjung Pinang, Indonesia. A total of 4 officials from UTHM participated in this visit led by Dr. Shahmir Hayyan bin Sanusi (Head of International Mobility Department at International Office), Dr. Siti Marpuah (Lecturer of Center for General Studies and Co-Curriculum) and supported by En. Mohammad Zulkhibri Bin Rahmad (International Office administrative officer) and Pn. Zaitun Binti Mustaffa (International Office administrative officer).

The visit intends to increase the visibility of UTHM to students and educational institutions from Indonesia and to look for new ways to increase the number of Indonesian students at UTHM. This visit will also attract potential students, especially for the bachelor's, master's, and doctoral programs

The visit ended with the plan signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Universitas Ibnu Sina (UIS) and Faculty of Mechanical And Manufacturing Engineering, a student and staff exchange agreement, and an international seminar between universities and UTHM soon.







INTERNATIONAL PROMOTION ACTIVITIES: EDUCATION PROMOTION YES2MALAYSIA EDUCATION MALAYSIA EXPO 2022 TO BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN, BRUNEI.

17th August until 20th August 2022, Brunei:

Two delegates from Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) participated in the Yes2malaysia Education Malaysia Expo in Bandar Seri Begawan, Brunei. This visit was led by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Muhammad Ramlee Bin Kamarudin (Director of International Office) and assisted by Dr. Noraini Binti Ruslan (Lecturer of the Faculty of Applied Sciences and Technology).

The exhibition was held at Mulia Hotel, Bandar Seri Begawan. expo attracted more than 600 visitors to the UTHM booth, most of whom were interested in studying at UTHM at Bachelor, Master and PhD levels. During the program, they also visited the Faculty of Engineering at Universiti Technology Brunei (UTB), as well as schools and colleges in Bandar Seri Begawan. Finally, through the visit, UTHM found an educational consultant from Brunei, Avicenna Resources, who is looking to collaborate with UTHM and promises to recruit students from Brunei.







MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) SIGNING PROGRAMME BETWEEN INSTITUTIONS FOR THE OFFICIAL VISIT OF THE PRIME MINISTER OF TURKEY

17th July 2022, Turkey:

UTHM was represented by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic and International), Professor Ts. Dr. Azme Khamis, while Ankara Medipol University was represented by its Rector, Professor Dr. Ahmet Zeki Şengil, who also represents Ankara Medipol University, Istanbul. The intention of this MoU signing is to strengthen national education through internationalisation activities, Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) has established collaboration with two universities in Turkey, namely Istanbul Medipol University (IMU) and Ankara Medipol University (AMU), especially in the academic and research fields.

In order to realise the collaboration, a signing ceremony of the memorandum of understanding (MoU) was held on July 7, 2022 at the Presidential Palace, Presidential Complex, Ankara.

The MoU was signed during the official visit of the Prime Minister of Malaysia, Dato' Sri Ismail Sabri Yaakob, to Turkey from July 5 to 8, 2022.





INTERNATIONAL PROMOTION ACTIVITIES: PROMOTION OF EDUCATION FACULTY OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY (FTK) TO JOGJAKARTA, INDONESIA

7th August until 14th August 2022, Indonesia:

This visit is led by Professor Dr. Chan Chee Ming and assisted by Dr. Nor Hazren Abdul Hamid. The industry and places visited are Ullen Sentalu, Small and Medium Industry (PT. Biotek Cipta Kreasi), small and medium industry (Fabio Yogurt), Ngobaran beach, Kalibiru, Taman Wisata Sungai Mudal, Chocolate Monggo Museum New Factory Store and CSR at a snake fruit farm.

The purpose of this visit is to increase the number of students of the Faculty of Engineering Technology (FTK) for the international mobility program (Outbound). It is also to improve the image of the university through bilateral relations with foreign universities through various activities and collaborations, as well as to carry out promotional activities for UTHM.
